Period of acceptability of life-saving appliances which are subject to deterioration with age

Period of acceptability of life-saving appliances which are subject to deterioration with age should be clearly mentioned by the Maker. If the Maker does not indicate the period of acceptability then the life-saving appliance will not accepted by this Administration.

Acceptance of servicing stations intended to Inflatable liferafts, inflatable lifejacket, and marine evacuation system.

Servicing stations intended to Inflatable liferafts, inflatable lifejacket, and marine evacuation system are accepted by this Administration if they are accepted or approved by a Recognized Organization recognized by this Administration.

Acceptance of life-saving appliances and arrangements which have not been previously approved by the Administration

This Administration will accept life-saving appliances and arrangements which have not been previously approved by this Administration if they are provided by a Type Approval Certificate confirming the compliance with SOLAS/LSA Code requirements as applicable. Type Approval Certificate should be issued by a Recognized Organization recognized by this Administration.

Acceptance of navigational equipment (SOLAS V/18)

This Administration will accept navigational equipments which have not been previously approved by this Administration if they are provided by a Type Approval Certificate confirming the compliance with SOLAS requirements as applicable. Type Approval Certificate should be issued by a Recognized Organization recognized by this Administration.
