## PROCEDURE FOR THE REGISTRATION OF PLEASURE YACHTS **UP TO 24 M WITH NO CHARTER ALLOWANCE**

### Administrative requirements:

- 1. Application for Registration
- 2. Copy of legalised and/or apostilled Bill of Sale or Builder's Certificate
- 3. Good Standing Certificate and Certificate of Incumbency listing the Directors or passport copy
- 4. Permission for Transfer or recent Transcript of Register and/or recent Non-**Encumbrance Certificate**
- 5. Accounting Authority Identification Code (A.A.I.C.) / P.S.A. and confirmation from the Authority that they are settling the Radio Traffic Accounts
- 6. Certificate of Entry from the vessel's P & I (Third Party Liability & Crew)
- 7. Payment of the relevant fees

# **Technical Requirements:**

## Statutory:

- a. Compliance assessment (Completed by the Master and countersigned by the Registered Owner)
- b. MARPOL compliance:
  - E.I.A.P.P. Certificate (required for any engine installed after 1st January 2000 with output power of more than 130 kW);
  - I.S.P.P. Certificate (Yachts which are certified to carry more than 15 persons)
